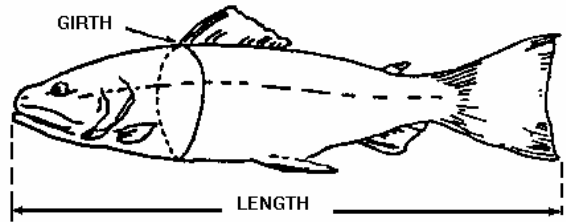

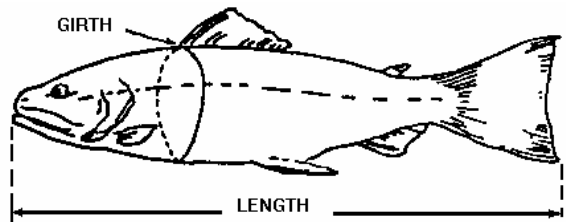

FISHING CONTEST RULES

1. Include a picture of your catch with your entry if possible.
2. Contestants may turn in unlimited number of entries.
3. Length will determine winners; girth will serve as a tiebreaker.
4. Awards will be given for the largest fish in the following categories:

Categories

1. Muskie
2. Northern pike
3. Walleye/Sauger
4. LargeMouth/SmallMouth Bass/White Bass
5. Inland Trout
6. Lake Michigan Lake Trout
7. Lake Michigan Brown Trout

Categories

8. Lake Michigan Rainbow Trout
9. Coho Salmon
10. Chinook Salmon
11. Bluegill Min Length 8"
12. Perch Min Length 10"
13. Crappie Min Length 10"
14. Special (out of ordinary)

5. Only one Trophy or cash Award is given per person. If you win in more than one category the other categories will be added to the trophy.
6. Fish must legally be **caught by hook, legal size and caught within Wisconsin or its boundary water.**
7. All entries must be verified by at least one person with his address or telephone number.
8. Contest runs from November 1st to October 31st. All fish caught in October must be turned in no later than October 31st. **No exceptions!**
9. You have three weeks from the day you caught your fish to submit your entry form. **Two forms are needed.** One copy goes to the Awards Committee Chairperson, the second copy to the Editor.
10. Junior anglers are children of Club members up to 16 years old. Children of Club members 17 and 18 do not pay Club dues but must compete with the adult anglers. Children older than 18 are not eligible for the contest under their parent's membership.

NOTE: If neither Editor nor Awards Committee Chairperson is present at a meeting turn your entry forms over to the President. He will be responsible to get the copies to the Editor and the Awards Committee Chairperson. The address of the Editor and Awards Committee Chairperson are on the first page of every newsletter. The Awards Committee Chairperson has the final say on all contest rules and questions.
